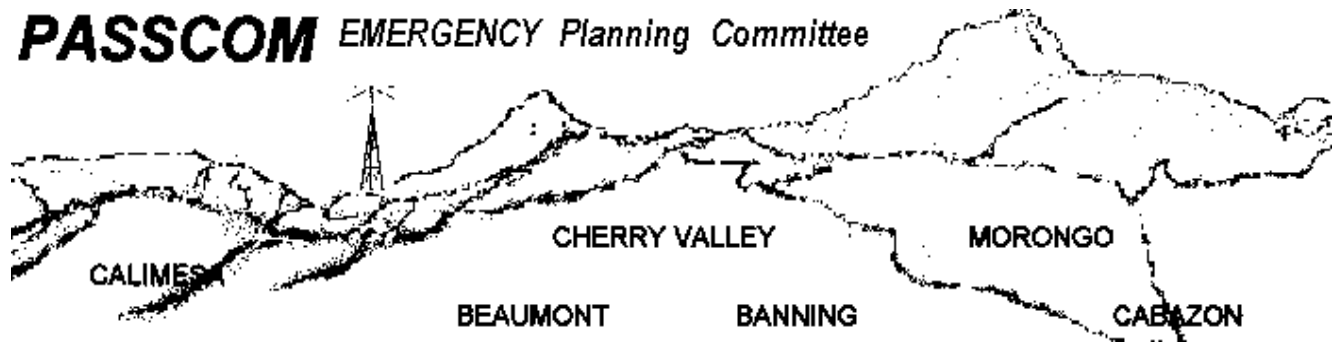


# **PASSCOM** EMERGENCY Planning Committee

<b>Hospital Foundation</b>		
<b>Riverside County EMD</b>	Eric Cadden reported about the Corona Virus. There are 6 people with the virus. Two of them were on a cruise ship. The tennis tournament was canceled. Dr. Kaiser is doing an amazing job. He doesn't take things lightly. Public Health is watching the virus very closely. There was a declaration after the first case. This declaration will not bring in more resources. They have to make a decision right before as to whether to cancel an event or not. (Mike Simon said there may be a possible change with stage coach days). The job position closed on March 6. They had 65 applicants. The CERT field day is still on (as of now). CERT class in Calimesa on May 1, 2, and 3. They had the first fire of the season.	
<b>San Geronio Medical Hospital</b>	Joey Hunter reported that they have had a lot of security issues. They have had a lot of break-ins and a vehicle was stolen. The FBI will come out tomorrow to do a risk assessment. They have not seen an increase in flu but have seen an increase in gun shots and stabbings. Regarding the corona virus they have had a lot of meetings and are well prepared. Vendors are only giving the hospitals the supplies that are needed (what they usually order). They have a table top exercise this Thursday. They also see many travelers from Morongo

	<b>Round Table Other Agency / Organization Reports</b>	
<b>Plantation on the Lakes</b>	Mike Simon reported that the CERT field day is coming up on March 21. Make sure you go if you sign up. If you change your mind please let them know.	
<b>CHP</b>	Matt Napier reported that they are always busy when it rains. 10 freeway project just started- east bound is restriped. There is a one foot change. People need to slow down to 60mph and watch. Project is a three year project. The 60 project is on time.	
<b>Four Seasons-EPC</b>	Mike Mendoza reported that they are going to put up hand wash signs and have put 10 more hand sanitizers around. They have also encouraged people to clean up after themselves. They have talked about cleaning the pool balls and cues.	
<b>Calimesa City Council</b>	Ed Clark reported that they approved funding to get parts of Roberts road back open. The stop signs are official on Singleton and they are going to fix the road so peoples trash cans do not get hit.	
<b>Beaumont-Cherry Valley Water District</b>	James Bean reported that the water district is evaluating needs. They are also looking for grants and funding. They are going to be running some drills for emergency response. The new norm is that there are going to be power shut offs- how are we going to deal with it. They are being proactive. SCE has been good to give them notice. Power outages need to be added to the disaster plan. They will be meeting with the water	

	district board. They will be redrilling two wells and will be drilling two additional wells. The EPA has several Apps that he has found beneficial. They are “Response on the go,” UV index” and “Air now”. He explained why he like them. The water district is in good shape. They can move water from one side of town to the other. There are about 45,000 resident that receive water and about 18,000 service connections.	
<b>Four Seasons</b>	Larry Goodreau told about his experience with a TIA. Yesterday he tried to read a paper but he couldn't read it nor could he talk. He spent the day at the VA hospital not knowing if this would end. He was incoherent and inarticulate. He was very week and it was scary. It lasted several hours and the VA hospital was great.	
<b>Solera</b>	Dennis Rice reported that he is the chairman for emergency readiness. He handed out an emergency plan form. (It is still a work in progress.) There are a lot of plan variables. It has been an interesting process trying to figure out responsibilities. This is good for HOA's and has different conditions. Regarding the corona virus –Solera did put out a flyer to residents. It is found on their website - soleraep.com. It has some great information	
<b>Highland Springs Village</b>	Fran Flanders reported that they are preparing for a 60 year reunion. She also shared an email. The corona virus only infects your lungs. It said to stock up on zinc and use it if you start feeling sick. There will be no antiviral meds this year. The corona virus droplets remain contagious for about one week on paper. It also had many other suggestions to stay healthy.
