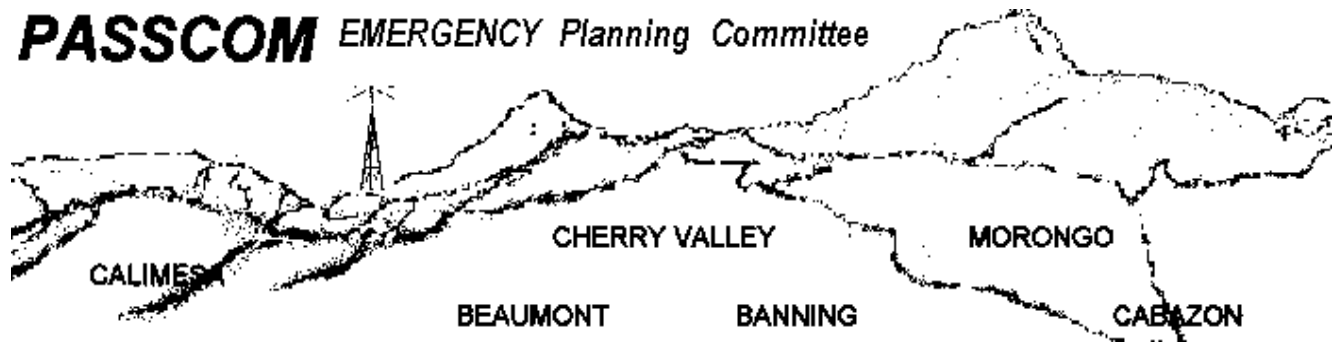

Riverside County EMD	Justin Gardiner reported that Emergency Management Accreditation Program (EMAP) grant was approved. He will be bringing in his sign in sheet next time. This means that they can do commercials, more CERT trailers, etc.. Next year they can do train the trainers classes. The Cert class last week went very well. San Gorgonio Medical Hospital Banning P.D.	Joey Hunter reported that there is a Seminary for Disaster Golf Tournament coming up.	
Calimesa F.D.	Vincent Avila reported that they are still under staffed. The people they hired quit. Next week they are interviewing for a Captain. Ten officers are off for injuries but are coming back. They are trying to get 31 officers. They are at 25 currently. On Thursday and Friday they are going to clean up homeless camps. They are attending the Homeless meeting this Thursday. If you see people dropping people off please let him know. They are always looking for volunteers. Blair Ball asked if there were only 15 homeless people in the area. Vincent reported that there are at least 40.	
AMR	Tim O'Connell reported that the fire on the golf course yesterday was quickly taken care of. It was a homeless person's fire. Then another fire was started by a homeless person. Calimesa is growing quickly. The council approved the Emergency Plan.	
	Reported that they are getting more aggressive with medication and training. They work with ISAMA. There is a change taking place Oct.1, MSJC (Mt. San Jacinto College) is hosting a 9/11 ceremony in Banning.	
Presenter	Cynthia McClain- Coast Guard Auxiliary Cynthia deals with many different departments i.e. fire, police, park rangers etc. Communication is an issue. She is trying to help people be safe on the water. She inspects the boats, preferably before they hit the water.(She handed out a paper in a bag with information in it). She has 35 people in the unit. She needs volunteer help. Operations start in Feb. They meet the fourth Tuesday of every month in Redlands. They do training everywhere. (Anita Worthen invited her to attend the job fair). Cynthia's next meeting is at Denny's off Alabama on Sept. 24 at 7p.m. Larry asked about the recent boat fire. Cynthia replied that there were fir extinguishers on the boat that were never used
